Papaya ringspot virus nearly wiped the crop out, causing production in Hawaii to drop 50 percent between 1993 and 2006. Luckily, scientists developed a genetically modified papaya, known as the Rainbow papaya, which is resistant to the virus.
The seeds resemble peppercorns and are edible. They can be ground up and used as a substitute for black pepper.
