

The grape berry moth is the most destructive grape insect in the eastern U.S. **Using** insecticides can help save your grapes, preventing these pests from returning next year.

Young grapevines do not compete well with grasses and weeds, such as Johnson grass and poison ivy. Herbicides can help decrease weed populations before planting grapevines. Pesticides can ensure there is enough wine to go around!
